## Meeting Minutes

June 12, 2018 7:00 p.m. David YMCA Conference Room

Meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Chris Snyder. Motion to approve the May minutes was made by Christine Ferrante, seconded by Deanna Heropoulos. Motion approved.

President Chris Snyder opened the meeting with a welcome to new members in attendance.

### Coach's Report:

- Coach Megan reported that Captain Paige Shackelford will be moving out of the area, therefore she appointed Allie Fialko to replace her as the new captain.
- The former Branin Invitational will become the Federal League Championship meet where ½ of the points from this meet and ½ of the points from dual meets will decide the Federal League Champion. The meet is to be held on December 28<sup>th</sup>. Power Point System will still decide the 1<sup>st</sup> Team, 2<sup>nd</sup> Team and Honorable Mention Team.
- Coach met with the Y about the air quality system. It was discussed that a new system was in the planning stages. It did not get approved this fiscal year. It seems that the new system will not be installed until after the 2018-2019 swim season. Concerns were discussed about the ability of the current system to handle the air quality to the proper health specifications. Chris will contact school officials and YMCA Director Jean Campbell to discuss further.

### President's Report:

- Chris Snyder noted that the meeting schedule has been set for the upcoming year for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of each month through February. At that time we will decide, based on member's schedules, on a month to month basis to finish the year out.
