Meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Chris Snyder. Motion to approve the minutes made by Christine Ferrante and seconded by Leslie Murphy.

Coach's Report given by Chris Snyder for Coach Megan in her absence:

- Meeting with the captains Sunday, August 19th to decide on team suits.
- Booked and approved to use Room A101 (fishbowl) at JHS for the September, October, November, December, January and February booster meeting dates.
- Weight lifting will begin the week of September 17th. It will run on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the fall from 5:20-6:20pm.
- David YMCA Phantoms' Team starts Monday, September 10th from 3-5pm. High Schoolers will be charged a rate of \$160.00. There is a reduced rate for swimmers who participate in fall sports; contact YMCA for cost. Each high school swimmer is required to swim in 2 YMCA meets before high school season starts.
- Currently have the following numbers for the upcoming season:
 - 22 Seniors.
 - 13 Juniors.
 - 14 Sophomores.
 - 12 Freshmen (based on attendance at the 8th grade meeting in May).

Treasurer's Report:

Jeannine Thomas reported that she will file the year end financials with the state and that the current club balance is \$3,475.11 and the student account balance totals \$1555.30

Old Business:

- Chuck Loveless reported that the car wash held on June 23rd brought in \$340.00. The next car wash is planned for the same location at the Wendy's on Portage Street on August 25th. Suggestion was made to advertise on the new team Facebook page. A big thank you to the Loveless family for organizing this event.

- Kick-off Picnic is Sunday, August 26th at the South Park Pavilion at 2:00 p.m. Main Dish is provided by the booster club. Freshman are to bring 2 cases of bottled water, Sophomores - individual snack items, Juniors - side dish/appetizer/ fruit, and Seniors - hand held dessert items. David Zablo and Pina Weinland will have program order forms, signs/decal order forms and apparel order forms respectively. Committee sign-up sheets including away and home feeds will also be present. Parents can pay their \$50.00 swimmer fee at that time as well. It was discussed that Coach Megan should stress the Athletic Code of conduct at this meeting.
