

**JHS Swimming and Diving Booster Club
Meeting Minutes
June 7, 2016 7:00 p.m. JHS A101**

Meeting was called to order at 6:35 p.m. by Chris Snyder. Motion to approve the May Minutes was made by Deanna Heropoulos and seconded by Tom Fialko. Motion approved.

Coach's Report:

- Shady Hollow summer conditioning began. Averaging 25-30 swimmers including alumni.
- Car wash signups are underway for Saturday.
- Will be ordering 200 caps this year using the funds from the blood drive. 150 was not enough last year.
- Coach will be traveling over the next three weeks for vacation, a swim camp and conference. Meghan will be running conditioning.

Treasurer's Report: Jeannine Thomas reported the current club balance is \$2,805.12. Student account balance is \$1,000. We are holding a total of \$3,805.12 heading into the new season (less \$1,200 due to Shady Hollow for conditioning).

New Business:

Christine Ferrante suggested a fundraiser with Handel's Ice Cream. The proceeds are 20% of sales when a flyer is turned in. She will get details and see about scheduling after school starts so team members can pass out flyers to students.

Blood Drive is tentatively scheduled for November 19. Details to come later.

Parents also discussed dividing responsibilities for the team program to make sure we had it ready for the first home meet.
