

**JHS Swimming and Diving Booster Club
Meeting Minutes
September 12, 2017 7:00 p.m. JHS A101**

Meeting was called to order at 7:04 p.m. by Chris Snyder. Motion to approve the August minutes was made by Jeanine Thomas and seconded by Stephanie Zablo. Motion approved.

President's Report: Chris Snyder extended thanks to everyone for helping with and donating to team picnic. We had a huge turnout. Also thanks to Old Carolina for their food donation.

Coach's Report:

- Coach Megan had old materials to review with Booster Club. All can be discarded.
- Intent to swim forms for Ned Reeb are still needed.
- Training Equipment needed: silicone caps (sell at cost) reserve for allergy issues, batteries for Tempo trainers (contact M. Biclowski as possible source).
- Computer has been transferred from Ziders. The iPad is not functional and may need replaced (used for recording swims)
- Latex cap supply low. Coach Megan will reorder.

Treasurer's Report: Jeanine Thomas reported a fiscal year end June 30 balance of \$5,576.93 and athlete account balance of \$1051.80. Recent deposits included a private donation, car wash proceeds and fees from the Shady Hollow swim clinic that Matt Ziders donated back to the team.

Old Business:

- Apparel first order due date – 10/6.
- Future car washes – hold off on scheduling for now with favorable financial position.
- Chipotle Fundraiser – confirmed for December 6th (before the Viking Invitational). 50% back to the team.
- Ned Reeb – hotel booked. Confirmed to work with athletic office on charter bus. Chris Snyder will reach out to Bella Sera catering for possible donation of Friday night meal.
- Viking meet – CSU charging \$402 for 2 rooms this year. Coach Megan said that 1 room would be sufficient for resting and most swimmers used common areas in addition to the “sleeping” room.
- Program ads due November 11.
- Christmas Raffle – donations coming in, still need a few more dates filled.
- Banquet set at Executive Events Center.
- Team Feeds – booster club will cover post-meet meal expenses for all away meets except during holiday break.

New Business:

There was a question about pre-season diving fees. Megan shared that she and Coach Barr reviewed comparable programs and that the fee was in line with others pre-season programs.
