Meeting Minutes December 7, 2015 7:00 p.m.

Meeting was called to order at 7:05 p.m. by Chris Snyder. Motion to approve the November Minutes was made by Mike Biclowski and seconded by Steve McCarren. Motion approved.

The results of the blood drive were discussed before other reports for time purposes. We collected enough units to get the \$700 award. The \$700 will be directed to the latest apparel invoice because it has to be paid directly to a vendor. Another blood drive will be scheduled for March 12th at the David YMCA. The Y will work with us again to publicize the event. Tom Fialko will communicate the results of the blood drive to families.

Coach's Report:

- Monday 12/14 practice is cancelled due to lights being installed in the pool area at the Y. An optional practice will be held on Sunday 12/13.
- The Perry meet has been rescheduled for Monday, 1/11 at Perry.
- All Ned Reeb entries were accepted and all athletes will swim their requested events. 49 swimmers are attending the meet in A and B flights.
- Dome caps are in and there will be 15 extra available for sale to any swimmers who did not purchase one on the first order.

Treasurer's Report:

- Report through November distributed with current balance of \$5519.70. This does not include any proceeds from Program sales or collected funds from raffle tickets for student accounts. Regarding student accounts, a single account will be noted on the financial report and a separate spreadsheet (to be provided by Marcy) will track individual account balances.

Old Business:

- Chipotle fundraiser is December 9th from 5-9 pm. After reviewing the agreement, it seems that carryout/online orders are eligible, but gift cards are not.
- Program – the program is not complete because of a delay from Lifetouch with team photos as well as some delinquent senior bios.
- Senior Banners – all senior athletes participated in the township banner and the township approved the application. Banners will go up on the poles near the YMCA the first week of January.
- Best Buy Raffle – ticket sales going very well. About 75% of the team participated. Funds being applied to either Ned Reeb or accounts for other expenses. Full report coming in January.
- Team Christmas Party – Wednesday December 23rd after practice at McCarren's house. Details to be provided to the team.
- End of Season Banquet – McCarrens, after meeting with several caterers, suggested that we move the banquet to Executive Event Center in Perry Township. They can provide buffet style dinner (inclusive with china, place settings, etc) for \$13-14 per person. A \$500 deposit is required to hold the date (March 13). Many people at the meeting gave good endorsements and those present agreed to reserve the location instead of holding the

banquet at the high school. Barb and Steve will have more banquet details at the next booster club meeting.

Ned Reeb – Final Details

- There are 15 parent rooms reserved at the Hampton Inn where swimmers are staying. Parents will be asked on check hallways, etc as needed Friday night. Parents will be asked to notify Coach Ziders if their swimmer will be staying with or traveling home with them on Saturday instead of on the team bus.
- Swimmer rooms are assigned according to flight. Swimmers will be given room assignments upon arrival at the hotel.
- Coach Ziders and Coach Megan will be on deck all day for both flights, prelims and finals. Coach Lauren will travel with A flight, Coach Anna will travel with B flight.
- No fast suits will be worn for relays (whenever possible). Fast suits may be worn for individual events.
