

Rules and Operations for the Jackson Swimming and Diving Booster Club Annual Scholarship Program (2021)

1. The Jackson Swimming and Diving Booster Club Annual Scholarship Program is open to any senior student from Jackson High School who has participated in the swimming and diving program for two (2) or more seasons including their senior year and plans on attending college in the next year.
2. Every applicant must complete the Scholarship Application (“Application”) in full and submit it by the designated date (Friday, February 12, 2021) to Coach Doug. No Applications will be accepted after the deadline.
3. Each completed Application will be photocopied and assigned a number to identify it. This will serve to blind the reviewers to the identity of the applicant.
4. The blinded Applications will be reviewed by a committee of 5 or more preselected judges. The judges must not include any relatives of a senior class applicant.
5. The Applications will be scored numerically 1-X, with the lowest score going to the highest rated application.
6. The total points of all the scores will be tabulated.
7. The Applications with the lowest point totals will be the winners of the scholarships.

8. The number of scholarships awarded each year is determined by the Jackson Swimming and Diving Booster Club's Board of Directors based upon the financial situation each year.

9. Scholarship recipients will be announced at the end-of-season Team Banquet.

10. To be eligible for a scholarship, all team fees must be paid by application deadline.
